

WOMEN'S, GENDER, AND SEXUALITY STUDIES (WGSS)

WGSS 2010 Introduction to Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies (3 credits)

General Education: American Experience

Survey of and introduction to the study of women's lives and the social construction of gender and sexuality across times and cultures. Thematic examination of the diversity of women's experiences in families, at work, with the law, in health care, in literature, in the media, in language; exploration of differences and similarities, including ethnicity, sexuality, class, and age. Examination of ideals of femininity and masculinity in the US and elsewhere. Typically Offered: Varies.

WGSS 4040 (s) Special Topics (1-16 credits, max 99)

WGSS 4100 Feminist Theory and Action (3 credits)

This course examines a range of feminist theory, including both classic and lesser-known texts, while grounding the study of theory in an examination of historical and contemporary feminist activism. The course covers some of the key concepts and debates within feminism and explores the relationship between theory and action. Students learn how to read theory and apply their knowledge to current events, issues, and problems in the United States and globally.

WGSS 4950 (s) Women's Center Internship (1-6 credits, max 6)

Directed student internship relevant to women's, gender, and sexuality studies, and done in conjunction with the Women's Center. Various credits depending on the length and type of internship. Typically Offered: Varies.

Prereqs: Permission of the director of the Women's Center

WGSS 4980 (s) Internship in Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies (1-6 credits, max 99)

Directed student internship in approved setting relevant to women's, gender, and sexuality studies with campus, local, national, or international organizations or offices. Various credits depending on the length and type of internship.

Prereqs: WGSS 2010, Permission of the Coordinator of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies.
